Before we arrive

- Move small valuables and breakables (photos, decor, collectibles).
- Clear 2–3 feet from walls where possible (furniture, bins, toys).
- Remove fragile wall hangings and store safely.
- Decide paint colors and sheen (or note that you want recommendations).
- If you have alarm systems or gate codes, share access details.

Interior prep (best results)

- Keep pets secured and provide a clear path to work areas.
- Remove outlet covers if you prefer (we can do it if needed).
- Let us know about water stains, smoke stains, or peeling areas.
- Turn on HVAC/heat as needed for proper drying (season dependent).
- If children's rooms are involved, plan a safe play zone away from work areas.

Exterior prep (quick wins)

- Move vehicles away from the work zone (driveway/garage access).
- Clear patio furniture, grills, and potted plants near walls.
- Trim back landscaping that touches siding/trim if possible.
- Note any soft wood/rot spots or loose boards you want us to inspect.
- Secure pets and keep gates accessible.

Day-of checklist

- Confirm preferred contact method (call/text/email).
- Share parking guidance and where to place equipment.
- Point out any areas of concern before we start (repairs, stains, peeling).
- Walkthrough at the end for touch-ups and final approval.

During the project

- Keep walkways clear so we can move tools safely.
- Avoid touching freshly painted surfaces until we confirm dry time.
- Ventilate as advised for faster curing (weather dependent).
- If anything changes (scope/timeline), tell us early so we can adjust cleanly.

After we finish (care tips)

- Gentle cleaning only for the first 14–30 days while paint cures.
- Avoid tape on freshly painted walls/trim for at least 2 weeks.
- If you notice a small issue, contact us and include a photo so we can help quickly.

Notes for your estimate / walkthrough

Write anything you want us to know: color codes, rooms, repairs, access notes, deadlines, etc.
